Heat Illness Prevention; Requiring certain employers to implement an outdoor heat exposure safety program that has been approved by specified agencies; specifying requirements for the safety program; providing responsibilities for certain employers and employees; providing an exception; requiring specified annual training on heat illness and providing requirements for such training, etc. Effective Date: 10/1/2023

Rec./Autopsy Reports of Minor Victims of Domestic Violence: Creates exemption from public records requirements for autopsy reports of minors whose deaths were related to acts of domestic violence; provides exceptions; requires that any viewing, copying, or handling of such autopsy reports be under direct supervision of custodian of record or his or her designee; requires that certain surviving parents of minor whose death was related to act of domestic violence be given notice of petitions to view or copy minor's autopsy report & of opportunity to be present & heard at related hearings; provides for retroactive application; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity. Home Health Aides for Medically Fragile Children: Requires home health agencies to ensure that any tasks delegated to home health aides for medically fragile children to meet specified requirements; requires home health agencies to ensure that home health aides for medically fragile children employed by or under contract with them are adequately trained to perform tasks they will be delegated; provides certain individuals exemption from costs associated with specified training; authorizes home health aides for medically fragile children to perform certain tasks delegated by registered nurse; requires AHCA to conduct annual assessment related to certified health aide program; provides requirements for assessment; requires agency to submit report to Governor & Legislature by specified date each year, beginning on specified date; requires agency, in consultation with board, to develop home health aides
