Licensed Counseling for First Responders; Requiring an employing agency of a first responder to pay for certain licensed counseling for first responders; prohibiting the employing agency from requiring the first responder to use specified leave for such counseling under certain circumstances; authorizing a first responder to select a licensed mental health professional and providing requirements for the employing agency related thereto, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2023

Requires Department of Elderly Affairs to offer education about Alzheimer's disease & related forms of dementia to general public; requires employees of covered providers, health agency or nurse registry or companion or homemaker service provider, or nursing home, assisted living facility, adult family-care home, or adult day care center to complete specified training; authorizes DEA to adopt training curricula guidelines; provides requirements for training providers; authorizes completed training hours to count toward other required training or continuing education hours. Rec./Autopsy Reports of Minor Victims of Domestic Violence: Creates exemption from public records requirements for autopsy reports of minors whose deaths were related to acts of domestic violence; provides exceptions; requires that any viewing, copying, or handling of such autopsy reports be under direct supervision of custodian of record or his or her designee; requires that certain surviving parents of minor whose death was related to act of domestic violence be given notice of petitions to view or copy minor's autopsy report & of opportunity to be present & heard at related hearings; provides for retroactive application; provides for future legislative review & repeal of exemption; provides statement of public necessity.
