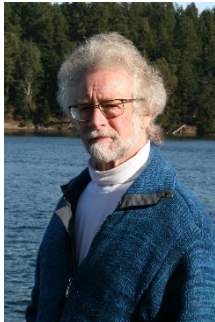
### Southern Gulf Islands Grandparent Storytelling Series - Mary Jones from Saturna Island
