Frequently Asked Questions

1. What do I do if I will be using an Ursuline family ring?
 - Turn in your Ursuline family ring to Ms. Estavan ASAP!
 - It must be given to Ms. Estavan personally (do not leave it in her office or with Ms. Kim)
 - It must be in a box or ziplock bag with your name clearly printed
2. What do I wear to the **Ring Ceremony**?
 - Graduation gown
 - White shoes with no higher than a 3 ½ inch heel
 - Modest jewelry
 - DO NOT wear the graduation cap
 - Under the gown wear a dress that is white or off white
3. What time do I need to be at Ursuline on Friday, August 30?
 - Check in with a teacher at Date Door by 9:00 am on Friday 9/5
 - You will wait to line up in St. Ursula
4. What time will Chapel open for my family?
 - All doors of Chapel will open at 9:30 am.
5. How long will the mass/ceremony take?
 - We expect the Mass & Ceremony to be approx. 1.5 hours
 - No one is allowed to stand in the aisles to take pictures or go back and forth between inside and outside chapel
7. Where do I go when the ceremony is over? When may I leave?
 - You will process out of **inside** chapel
 - You should plan to meet your guests in the Chapel Lobby
 - Get your personal belongings and you may leave
 - You do not need to check out with anyone
8. What do I do with the gown when the ceremony is over?
 - Keep your gown (and hang it up in a safe place when you get home) you will wear it again for Baccalaureate Mass in May, with the cap and tassel !!!!
9. What do I do if I will not be receiving a ring?
 - You may still attend if you would like to - see Ms. Estavan
