Protecting families starts with knowing their rights. El Concilio has expanded its resources by providing Know Your Rights presentations with both in-person and virtually to various nonprofit partners, community groups, school districts, agricultural partners, mental health resources and others. Keeping the community informed about their rights.

Support Our Immigrant Workforce—Strengthen Our Community!

Our team is working tirelessly to disseminate these vital resources, and we are available to further support our Agricultural business partners and their employees. However, as a nonprofit organization our limited funding is stretched thin and the need in the community is more urgent than ever. As a result, we are also actively seeking the business community's support to continue and expand these critical services.

The average cost per outreach session is \$500, while our staff cost to process an immigration application ranges from \$400 to \$1,500 depending on type and complexity. To ensure we can meet the growing demand of these services in the future, we need the support of the agricultural business community. This critical support to our efforts will empower and protect our immigrant community during this challenging time, while also strengthening the local economy of Ventura County.
