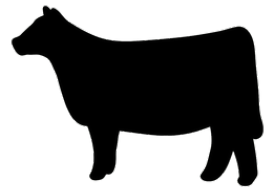

**Late Tag Orders are \$35.00 each are due June 12, 2026**

REMINDER: Once a heifer is validated her validation remains active until she ages out or until there are ANY changes made to her registration papers (ownership, etc.)  
As a reminder, any project that is sold through an auction or otherwise changes ownership must be revalidated.

- Unused tags are nonrefundable but are transferable within the county.
- Validation is required to be eligible to enter any Texas Major Show.
- **This is the ONLY validation for heifers to be shown at State Fair/Heart of Texas in Fall 2026**
- Heifers MUST be SOLELY owned.
- **Validating an animal does not enter them into a Texas Major Show.**
- All exhibitors must complete the age appropriate (JR, INT, SR) Quality Counts training to enter a Texas Major Show.
