



2026 AgriLife Extension Washington County 4-H Scholarship Guidelines

The 2026 AgriLife Extension – Washington County 4-H Scholarship program was developed by 4-H Parent Association in support of 4-H members from Washington County. The scholarship will be awarded in 2026 to 4-H members who meet the minimum requirements and will graduate from high school in May of 2026.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be an active 4-H member in good standing from Washington County.
 - Must be enrolled on 4-H Online (Active status on 4-H Online required prior to September 1, 2025)
 - Must attend 50% of the monthly club meetings in the year of application (September – April)
 - Must have participated in at least one project per year for 2 of 4 high school years (9th-12th grade)
 - Washington County Fair (livestock project, ag mechanics, country creations)
 - County (Roundup, Photography Contest, Food Show/Food Challenge)
 - District or State 4-H Events (any event that requires registration through 4-H Online)
 - Signed certification from Club Manager.
- Applicants must be a May 2026 graduate from a high school in Washington County.
 - Open to public, private, and homeschool students provided they can produce an official transcript.
- Applicants are encouraged to have worked the Washington County Fair Concession Stand and Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo (9th – 11th).
 - Scholarship amount varies based on years of participation in the concession stand
 - Washington County Fair is valued at \$250.00 per year
 - Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo is valued at \$125.00 per year
- Applicants graduating in May of 2026 must have worked at both the Washington County Fair and Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo 4-H Concession Stand in the Fall of 2025.
 - **Failure to work at both events in the fall of senior year makes the applicant ineligible.**

Application Process

Application must include the following to be considered:

- Completed 2026 AgriLife Extension – Washington County 4-H Scholarship Application
 - Must include signed statement of certification from Club Manager
 - Must include signed application certification statement

Final Decisions

- All concession stand participation will be verified with official sign-in sheets in the Extension Office.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Any modified application form will be disqualified.
- All Committee decisions are final.

Redeeming Scholarship

Payment must be made directly to a school/institution within **one year** of award.
