SOME SYMPTOMS OF DYSLEXIA



1 OUT OF 5 CHILDREN HAVE DYSLEXIA

- Cannot read sentences smoothly—may skip or swap out unfamiliar words
 - Does not associate print letters with sounds
 - Uncomfortable reading words sentences out loud
 - Confuses letters that look similar (e.g. "d" and "b")
 - Reading ability does not match their overall intelligence
