Paul Harvey was an American radio commentator and news columnist who used to close his radio program with the phrase, “And now you know the *rest* of the story.” Harvey’s mix of current-events news, human-interest anecdotes, and common-sense editorials reached some 24 million listeners via 1,600 radio stations daily.¹ His broadcasts specialized in revealing interesting tidbits on topics about which his listeners already knew, or at least *thought* they knew.
