Always wanting to work with students and families I started my career as a Child Protective Services Specialist with the Department of Child Safety in Arizona for 1 year then made the transition to Human Resources, I now have over 7 years of Human Resources experience from working at The University of Arizona and Pasadena Unified School District. In my current position as Program Resource Manager with the Student Wellness & Support Services Department with PUSD I support the various Depts under SWSS– Families in Transition, Health Programs, Child Welfare & Safety, Mental Health Depts., and our Youth in Foster Care.

I am married and have two kids that are currently attending PUSD. I also work part time at our Family restaurant Jake's Roadhouse as a waiter and selling Kettle Corn at the Monrovia Farmers Markets on Friday nights.



Skye P. Marshall, Honoree



Skye P. Marshall is an award-winning actress whose commanding screen presence and precision-driven performances have established her as one of Hollywood's most compelling rising talents. She currently stars opposite Academy Award® winner Kathy Bates in CBS's hit drama MATLOCK, which launched in 2024 and finished its debut season as broadcast television's #1 new series before returning this fall for its highly anticipated second season.

For her breakout portrayal of “Olympia,” a formidable attorney navigating power and ambition at one of New York's elite law firms, Marshall was honored with the “Best Supporting Actress” Award at the 2025 Critics Choice Association's Celebration of Black Cinema & TV and earned Critics Choice Award nominations for “Best Supporting Actress” in 2025 and 2026. She also won the “Best Breakthrough Talent” Award at the 2025 African American Film Critics Association's TV Honors and received a 2025 Gotham TV Award nomination for “Outstanding Supporting Performance in a Drama Series.”

Marshall first captivated audiences with her star-turning performance in writer-director Qasim Basir's feature film drama TO LIVE & DIE AND LIVE, which had its world premiere at the Sundance Film Festival in 2023 and released theatrically in May 2025. Deadline praised her work as “vibrant and compulsively switched on,” highlighting her exceptional range and screen command. Her performance earned her the Trailblazer Award at the 2025 African American Women in Cinema Film Festival. Additional film credits include starring opposite Peter Sarsgaard and Billy Magnussen in the dark comedy COUP! from writer-director duo Austin Stark and Joseph Schuman, which premiered at the Venice Giornate degli Autori Film Festival in 2023 and debuted in theaters in 2024, and Mo McRae's directorial debut thriller A LOT OF NOTHING, which released in theaters in 2023 following premieres at SXSW and the Seattle International Film Festival in 2022. On television, Marshall is also known for her recurring roles as “Mambo Marie” in parts 3 and 4 of Netflix's hit series, CHILLING ADVENTURES OF SABRINA, as “Kara Fowdy” in the CW's BLACK LIGHTNING, and a starring role as “Dr. Lex Trulie” in CBS' medical drama GOOD SAM. Additional credits include THIS IS US, 9-1-1, THE ROOKIE, NCIS, SHAMELESS, and GREY'S ANATOMY. Beyond her screen work, Marshall is a proud Chicago native and United States Air Force veteran who served pre- and post-9/11. A dedicated advocate for veterans' causes, mental health, Alzheimer's awareness, and meaningful representation in media, she was honored with the Humanitarian Award at the Creative Coalition Luncheon in 2025.

Marshall resides in Los Angeles.



Jane Wiseman, Honoree



Jane Wiseman serves as Head of Originals for Paramount+ where she is responsible for leading the development and production of the platform's expansive slate of original content including *Landman*, *MobLand*, *The Madison*, *Dexter*, *Yellowjackets* and recently greenlit series *Discretion* starring Nicole Kidman and Elle Fanning, *9/12* starring Jeremy Strong, and *Fear Not* starring Anne Hathaway. Before Paramount+, Wiseman was Head of U.S. Television for the global independent studio SISTER in 2024, where she oversaw the company's TV division with a focus on developing and producing premium scripted series.

Wiseman was among the first executives hired to build out the Netflix Original Series team in 2014. As Vice President of Original Series and Head of Comedy, she was a driving force behind Netflix's global expansion into original content, helping launch some of the platform's most acclaimed and award-winning series, including *Ozark*, *Narcos*, *Dead to Me*, *Russian Doll*, *Master of None*, *Never Have I Ever*, *Big Mouth*, *BoJack Horseman*, *The Kominsky Method*, and *Grace and Frankie*. Over her seven-year tenure, she played a key role in scaling Netflix's internal studio and led the content strategy, P&L, and production of approximately 20 series launches per year while managing a team of creatives and overseeing executives across production, business affairs, and creative strategy and analysis. Under her leadership, Netflix received over 100 Emmy and 30 Golden Globe nominations, including Netflix's first Golden Globe win for Best Television Series – Musical or Comedy with *The Kominsky Method* and Emmy wins for Director, Lead Actor, Supporting Actress (3x), Drama Series for *Ozark*, as well as Writing (2x), Comedy Series for *Master of None*.

Before Netflix, Wiseman served as SVP at Chernin Entertainment, where she worked on *New Girl* for FOX. She previously spent six years at NBC as SVP of Comedy, where she developed beloved hits like *Parks and Rec* and *Community*. Jane began her career at FOX, contributing to the development of the Emmy Award-winning *Arrested Development* and pop culture phenomenon *The Simple Life*.

Jane is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and resides in Los Angeles with her family.



Melissa Peterman, Host



Melissa Peterman is a talented actor, host and producer. Growing up in Minneapolis, Minnesota, she made a name for herself when she was cast in the local production of *Tony and Tina's Wedding*. She went on to perform in over 600 shows and became a staple on the comedy and improv scene. Peterman is currently starring in NBC's hit *Happy's Place* which will commence its third season this summer. The comedy reunites her with Reba McEntire with whom she co-starred in the hit comedy series, *Reba*, for seven seasons as Barbra Jean. She spent six seasons as Bonnie Wheeler on the ABC Family's #1 rated comedy series *Baby Daddy* which won the People's Choice

Award for "Favorite Cable TV Comedy." A few of Melissa's other notable television credits include a long-recurring role on the massive hit *Young Sheldon* and Executive Produced and starred in *Working Class* with Ed Asner. She has hosted numerous competition series, including four seasons of CMT's *The Singing Bee*, ABC Family's *Dancing Fools*, and ABC's *Bet on Your Baby*. She also served as executive producer and host for Fox First Run's *Person, Place or Thing* and *Punchline*, and is a frequent special guest on *25 Words or Less*. Peterman competed in Food Network's hit *Worst Cooks, Celebrity Edition* and created, produced and co-starred in the network's pilot Val's *Hot Dish*. Peterman co-hosted the E! Oscar's After Party and is a frequent guest co-host on Access Live, E! and Daily POP.

She returns as lead judge for the second season of Hallmark's popular unscripted reality competition *Finding Mr. Christmas*, the first season of which was nominated for a Critics Choice Award and a GLAAD Media Award. She can be seen in the Hallmark Channel Christmas movies *Haul Out the Holly* and its sequels, *Haul Out the Holly: Lit Up* and *Haul Out the Halloween*. This year, audiences will see her in the network's *All's Fair in Love* and *Mahjong*. Peterman made her feature film debut as Hooker No. 2 in the Coen Brothers' Oscar-winning film *Fargo*. Other film credits include *40 is the New Dead*, *Here Comes the Boom*, and *Dirty Politics*.

A long-standing guest of the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association, Peterman has hosted the "Sound of Music Sing-A-Long" at The Hollywood Bowl since 2004. She recently began hosting the LA Phil's annual *Holiday Sing-Along* at the Walt Disney Concert Hall. She has also joined Reba McEntire, Kelly Clarkson, George Strait and Lee Ann Womack on their respective tours.

Peterman is committed to many charities including Muhammad Ali's Celebrity Fight Night, Habitat for Humanity, The Red Cross, and Selfless Love Foundation.
