

Calvary's New Air Conditioning. By Tom Bible, Junior Warden

The Neisen company arrived Monday morning to install the new air conditioning units in Hannaford Hall. The work should last into next week. They will have a crane on site Saturday to remove the old compressor from the roof of Hannaford and place the new one. They will be working in and around Hannaford the whole week. There may be some periodic disruptions, but they should be minimal. They are working with us to provide newer, more efficient, and quieter systems.

Following work in Hannaford Hall there will be a pause before they start in the Sanctuary. We will keep you posted as the dates come closer.

The units in Hannaford Hall are two 7.5 ton units. The term "ton" comes from the sense that their output is equivalent to cooling with 7.5 tons of ice. Officially, a ton of AC = 12,000 BTUs.

Calculations show that these units will keep us comfortable during the hot summer days of 95 degrees plus. Each unit weighs about 500 pounds.
