	Tardiness will not be tolerated, as classes must begin promptly at 8:30
	AM. Students will be dismissed from the program for violation of

	not receive high school credit if they are dismissed nor will a refund

TRANSPORTATION:	Students should not arrive prior to 8:30 AM daily, as there is no adult supervision. Please DO NOT drop them off prior to that time. We cannot allow students to be unaccompanied in or around the building. This is a safety concern for your student.
	At the conclusion of the day each student will be required to leave campus at 3:00 PM . There are no after-care services provided. Administrators, faculty and staff will be leaving at that time as well. Please make the appropriate arrangements to have your student picked up at this time.
	There will be no public transportation to the program.
SPECIAL NOTE:	This document will be e-mailed to the parent of students accepted into the program and will be reviewed with the student on the first day of the program. We ask that parents review this document with their student very carefully and ensure they understand its content.
