Course Description:

This Connections Course is designed for 8th graders who are interested in pursuing Art at the high school level. Throughout the course, students will be introduced to many aspects of visual art, including, but not limited to: Art as personal communication, drawing, sculpture, ceramics, design, aesthetics, careers, Art criticism and Art history. At the conclusion of Intro to Art, students will have acquired the foundation to continue into any Visual Art pathway at the high school level.

- Students considering this course should be self-motivated and dedicated to improving their artistic voice, abilities, and understandings.
- Students will be expected to keep a sketchbook and use it regularly as a source of learning, inspiration and development of personal voice.
- Students enrolled in Intro to Art should understand that this course is for .5 high school credit. Assignments, projects and assessments will be of equal rigor to the high school Intro to Art curriculum.
- Students will be expected to complete the full semester once they are enrolled in the Intro to Art class (with the exception of extenuating circumstances, no student will be able to drop the class once enrolled).

Artwork can be submitted via email (photographs must be clear) or brought to Ms. Linehan in person to accompany your application.

- Completed Intro to Art application
- Completed Signatures page
- Two examples of **independently** completed original artworks:
 - One artwork should be inspired by the theme <u>dreams</u>. Interpret the theme how you like. Use the media of your choice. Include an *Artist statement* explaining your work.
 - The second artwork should be an <u>observational drawing of food</u>. Media should be graphite or color pencil and include the use of *value to model form* to make it look *realistic*.

No art reproductions, anime, or comic book style drawings will be accepted

After your application materials are received, they will be reviewed for admittance into the course. Using a rubric, applications will be ranked for admittance.

Curriculum taught in this course is one year ahead of the 8th grade Visual Arts Curriculum. Therefore, not all applicants will be accepted.
