

Protocol: Student is symptomatic at school

- Nurse (or school medical point of contact) should evaluate the student for symptoms (“Most common symptoms of COVID-19”).

IF ANY SYMPTOM:

- The student will be placed in the designated waiting room.
- Contact caregiver for pick-up. All students must have 3 emergency contact numbers that are able to pick up and we are allowed to share information with.

IF A CAREGIVER CAN PICK UP DURING THE DAY:

- Student waits to be picked up in the designated waiting room. Caregivers must wear a mask/face covering when picking up their student. Students cannot ride the school bus to get home. Caregivers and students should wash their hands upon arriving at home and change their clothes as a precaution.

IF A CAREGIVER CANNOT PICK UP DURING THE DAY:

- The student will wait in the designated waiting room until the end of the day to be picked up by their caregiver. The student cannot go home on a school bus or with other students.

IF THE SCHOOL CANNOT GET IN CONTACT WITH ONE OF THE 3 EMERGENCY NUMBERS:

1. The principal or designated employee will go to the student’s house.
2. If the parent/guardian are home and able to pick up the student, they will pick up the student immediately.
3. If the parent/guardian are unable to pick up the student, the school will provide transportation to the house.
4. If the school has tried the house and has had no communication with the emergency contacts before 3:00 pm, we will be forced to get in touch with local authorities.
