This team transports 725 public school students along with 41 special needs and 4 non-public students for a total of 770 riders. News You Can Use-Admissions Policy: *To attend preschool, a child must be three years old on or before Aug. 1 and no older than five.*

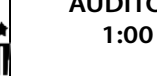
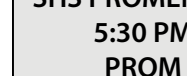
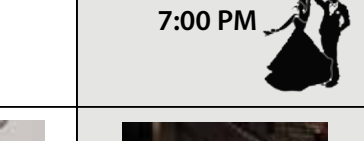

INSTRUCTIONAL & RELATED SERVICES	Includes salaries for professional teaching staff, librarians, school nurses, school psychologists, guidance counselors and attendance officers along with textbooks, teaching supplies, audio-visual equipment, and all necessary accouterments.
OPERATION TRANSPORTATION & MAINTENANCE	Custodial salaries, heating and utility costs, supplies for building operations, repairs to buildings, maintenance costs, plant equipment, and pupil transportation.
NON PROGRAMMED	State audit and auditor costs. At various times, it is necessary to transfer funds out of the general fund, usually to supplement federal programs and other accounts as needed. In most cases, funds are replaced when reimbursements are recovered.
