

# San Carlos Youth Center Drop-In Behavior Standards For Year August 2023-2024

## All participants will be expected to comply with the following Behavior Standards while at the San Carlos Youth Center

- Upon arrival, check-in to Drop-In with the Youth Center Staff at the front desk every day.
- All personal items must be stored on or next to the backpack hooks in the Youth Center lobby upon checking in.
- All bikes must remain outside, locked to the bike rack.
- Respect and listen to all Youth Center Staff Members. They are here to help and protect you.
- Swearing, name-calling, and put-downs are NOT allowed and will not be tolerated.
- If you have a disagreement with another participant, talk it out with them. The Youth Center Staff Members will assist you if you need help.
- Do not touch the property of other participants.
- Respect all Youth Center equipment. Each item should only be used for its intended use.
- Throw all trash away in the proper receptacle.
- If you check an item out, check it back in when you are finished. This includes games, sports equipment, and homework supplies.
- Roughhousing, fighting, and wrestling are not allowed. Always keep your hands to yourself.
- Do not climb on tables, chairs, or other furniture.
- Throwing items of any kind is prohibited unless the item is a ball in the Gym.
- Bikes, skateboards, and scooters are not allowed in front of the Youth Center or in the parking lot.
- Participants must clean up any trash or mess they make.
- The City of San Carlos is not responsible for any lost or stolen articles.
- Before playing a game, agree on the rules with each participant.
- If a piece of equipment is broken, notify a Youth Center Staff Member.
- The homework room is a NO TALKING area. Chromebooks are only used for homework purposes.
- Video games are a privilege and are limited to 20-minute sessions during the school year. Excessive yelling will result in loss of game time.
- All clothing, accessories, and personal items brought to the Youth Center (SCYC) shall represent SCYC's core values. Students are expected to make choices that are responsible, respectful, supportive, and safe for themselves, and others.
- Help keep the Youth Center a fun, inclusive, and safe place by following these rules!

***Failure to comply with these rules will result in disciplinary action, which can include time out from participating, suspension from a program/day/event, and suspension for a period from the Youth Center, or Youth Center membership being revoked. Please understand that the programs here at the Youth Center are a privilege, not a right. You must follow all rules to keep this privilege.***
