by Robin DiAngelo



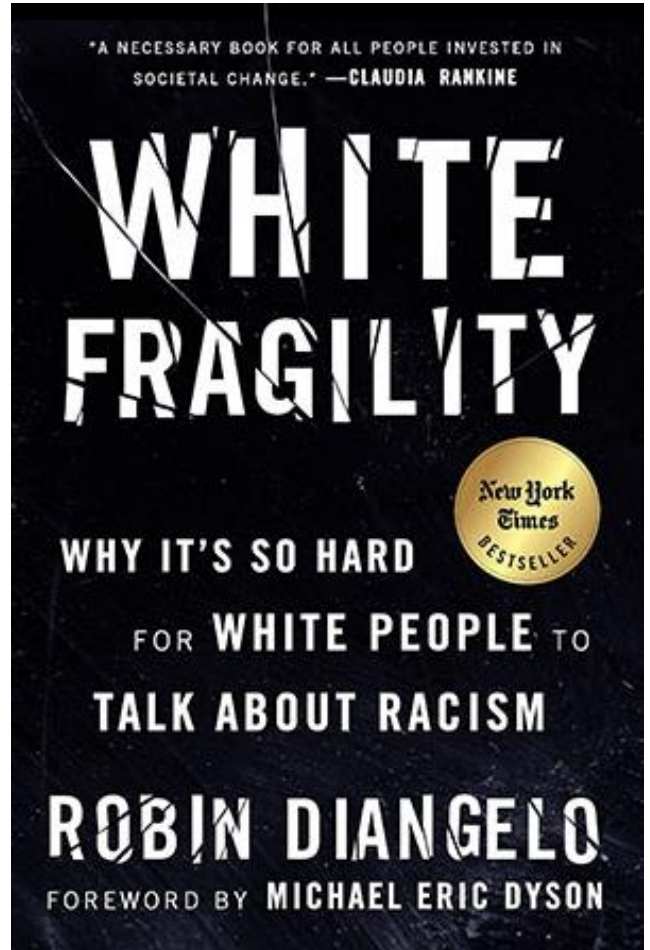
