



Join Your Fox Valley Memory Project Friends as we head to Green Bay for some FALL FUN!

Please join us on Thursday, October 11 as we travel on a coach bus with old and new friends for our next exciting day trip. This trip is sponsored by a donation from Twin Eagle Resource Management's charitable giving campaign.

We will board at 9 AM and depart from the Thompson Center on Lourdes, 2331 E Lourdes Dr in Appleton at 9:15 AM. Our first stop is the Neville Public Museum where we will have the opportunity to engage in a SPARK! program about the secret lives of bees. We will adventure into the hive to discover how bees live and work. We will also have the opportunity to take a 45 minute guided tour of the museum and special exhibits about the Green Bay Packers and the history of Brown County.

Our lunch will be served at Titledown Brewing Company. Located at a historic railroad depot, our luncheon site is the home of a popular area microbrewery and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Lunch will be your choice of a chicken breast smothered with cheese, mushrooms and onion served over rice pilaf with seasonal vegetables, baked cod served over rice pilaf with seasonal vegetables, beef tips served over mashed potatoes with seasonal vegetables or an 8 oz char broiled beef patty served on a brioche roll with fries.

Our afternoon stop will be a tour of the newsroom and studio of WBAY Action 2 News!

Participant Policy

Those attending this trip must be mobile and able to perform activities of daily living which include boarding and exiting the bus and walking to the venue. For safety reasons, everyone needs to travel with at least 1 partner! It is the responsibility of attendees to provide his or her own transportation to and from the pickup location. The coach bus has a bathroom. The bus has storage space and one seat for each passenger. We can accommodate folding walkers but are unable to accommodate wheelchairs.

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
