1. Please complete a registration form for **each person attending**:
 - **Name and address** Print your name and address clearly.
 - **Telephone number** Your phone number is necessary in case we have questions. A volunteer will call you prior to the event to confirm your attendance.
 - **Cost/Additional contribution** We are unable to refund your payment if you need to cancel after the deadline date, as we need to prepay the venues. Participant Policy

Those attending this trip must be mobile and able to perform activities of daily living which include boarding and exiting the bus and walking to the venue. For safety reasons, everyone needs to travel with at least 1 partner! It is the responsibility of attendees to provide his or her own transportation to and from the pickup location. The coach bus has a bathroom. The bus has storage space and one seat for each passenger. We can accommodate folding walkers but are unable to accommodate wheelchairs.
