

Worm Castings and TEAM

The fourth season of the History Park Organic Community Garden is underway. All weeds have been cleared and fresh topsoil added. The adding of mulch to the walkways will take place on a group work day in October.

This year we are also adding worm castings to all 92 plots. Worm castings are not a fertilizer. They are an all-natural soil builder made by the earthworm.
