Parks that Teach Guided Walking Tour

Participants will meet at the front of the Punta Gorda Library. From here a University of Florida Master Gardener will lead participants through a pathway with a unique ecosystem of mangroves. Participants will experience the habitats that support many different Florida animals. They will also learn the identity of different trees and shrubs and how they can fit into your home landscape.

Kayaking at Stump Pass Beach State Park

Participants will meet at Stump Pass Beach State Park in Englewood. Hooked on SUP Paddle Sports will be providing kayaks along with a 15 minute safety and instruction class. Participants will have up to 2 hours of time exploring around the two islands just east of the park's land base. Participants might see West Indian manatees, gopher tortoises, snowy egrets, least terns and magnificent frigate birds.

Loaner Bicycle Scavenger Hunt

Participants will meet at the Four Points Sheraton in Punta Gorda where they will all get a free bicycle to use. Everyone will receive a map with historic markers to locate and photograph between Fisherman's Village and Laishley Park. It they look hard enough among the markers participants will also find some beautiful painted stones which will be free for them to keep courtesy of our friends at Rockin Punta Gorda who made and hid their artwork. Participants who find the most markers in the quickest time will receive free certificates from our sponsors Harborwalk Scoops & Bites and Celtic Ray Pub.
