A “Quarter Frenzy” is best described as a raffle-style auction. It’s a great evening of fun and bargains using only quarters to bid on significant prizes typically valued from \$20 to \$75. These prizes are provided by local businesses. The proceeds support local nonprofits like TEAM Punta Gorda. Bidders purchase one or more bidding paddles (\$3 each or 3 for \$7) and bring a roll or two of quarters. The auction begins promptly at 6:30 pm. Attendees must be 18 years of age or older.

Come hungry! Food and non-alcoholic beverages are available for purchase with proceeds going to TEAM Punta Gorda. BYOB adult beverages. With lots of chances to win great prizes for quarters, it's a wild night of food, fun & friends that supports the many projects of TEAM Punta Gorda.

Bring some friends along and don't forget to bring a few rolls of quarters for bidding. Prepare yourself for a great time! No need register in advance. Just come and play.

Never been to a “Quarter Frenzy”?

Here's How It Works

- Guests purchase a numbered paddle (\$3.00 each or 3 for \$7.00)
- Guests bring a roll or two of nickels for bidding.
- Each item up for bid will be displayed for all guests to see.

- There will be a brief description, retail value, and how many quarters you will need to bid. Guests that want to play will give their bid (quarters) and hold up their numbered paddle or paddles.
- When all the bids are collected, the auctioneer will draw a numbered chip from the container. If the number on your paddle matches the number on the chip drawn, you've won that item. If the matching numbered paddle is not held up, the auctioneer will draw again, until there is a winner.
- Once a winner is declared all chips will be placed back in the container to be available for the next item to be auctioned off.
