

SIFAT'S DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS



While at camp, we ask students and adults:

- Wear modest shorts (when hands are extended down the leg, fingers must touch fabric).
- Sleeveless shirts and tank tops are NOT allowed. Shirts with spaghetti straps, open backs, or excessive armpit cutouts which expose torso or undergarments are NOT allowed. Large t-shirts that cover shorts should not be worn.
- Wear closed-toed and closed-heel shoes during certain recreation times and on work project sites.
- Wear modest one-piece bathing suits, modest tankinis, or two-piece suit covered with a dark colored t-shirt, if participating in water activities. Boys must wear a dark colored t-shirt while swimming as well. No speedos or bikinis.
- Wear modest shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses to worship. Dresses with spaghetti or small straps, open backs, and excessively short lengths are unacceptable (when hands are extended down the leg, fingers must touch fabric).
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear. (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc.) or wear pants or shorts with lettering across your bottom.

Note for work projects:

- Those doing painting, construction, and yard work may be asked to wear long pants while working on certain work sites.

Make sure your students do NOT pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
- Has spaghetti/small straps or open back.
- Is excessively short or tight fitting.
