Directions to the Rockland Community College 145 College Road, Suffern, NY 10901

From the east/west:

Take the New York State Thruway to Airmont Road, Exit 14B. At the end of the ramp, turn onto Airmont Road (right if coming from the east/south; left if coming from the west/north). Continue on Airmont Road, crossing Spook Rock Road (Airmont Road becomes Highview Road). Turn left onto College Road. Follow College Road, and turn left onto the campus at the main entrance.

From the south:

Take the Palisades Interstate Parkway or the Garden State Parkway Extension to the New York State Thruway, westbound. Take Exit 14B, Airmont Road. Follow the remaining directions from above.

From the north:

Take Route 202 west/south past the Palisades Interstate Parkway. Turn left at the 3rd traffic light onto Route 306. Turn right at the 3rd traffic light onto Viola Road. Turn left at the next traffic light onto College Road. The campus entrance is on the right.
