Coeur Alaska, Inc.'s Kensington Mine is an underground, hard rock gold mine located in the Berners Bay Mining District, which has had over 100 years of resource development.

The mine, which has a small footprint of approximately 240 acres, is accessed via water with the 45-mile commute along Lynn Canal.

In 2019, Kensington reached the milestone of over one million ounces of gold produced and celebrated its tenth full year of production on July 3, 2020.
