- Strongly encourage 'stay home if sick'.
- Promote healthy hygiene practices of handwashing and wearing a face covering.
- Plan is based off best known information at present and ammendable at any time.

01

What we are currently doing.

Stay home. Stay safe.

Phase

All worship, bible studies and church activities take place online.

02

Begins when Williamson/Travis County COVID-19 daily reported positive cases indicate 28 continuous days of decline

Ministry teams and bible study groups may gather in person with strict physical distancing protocols. No more than 10 persons may gather.

Worship remains online only.

Phase

Church staff continue to work from home.

03

Begins when Williamson/Travis County COVID-19 daily reported positive cases indicate 42 continuous days of decline

Worship may take place in-person with strict physical distancing protocols and revised practices. Online/livestreaming worship is still available.

Fellowship activies may resume with moderate physical distancing protocols.

Church staff continue to work from home.

Phase

04

Begins when Williamson/Travis County COVID-19 daily reported positive cases indicate 56 continuous days of decline

Worship may take place in-person with moderate physical distancing protocols and revised practices.

Online/livestream worship is still availible.

Homebound communion may resume.

Visits to hospitals/skilled nursing facilities may resume with care and following guidelines set forth by those entities.

Church staff may resume typical work.
