The Right Rev. Mark MacDonald became the Anglican Church of Canada's first National Indigenous Anglican Bishop in 2007, after serving as bishop of the U.S. Episcopal Diocese of Alaska for 10 years. His formal education includes a B.A. in religious studies and psychology at the College of St. Scholastica in Duluth, Minn., an M.Div. from Wycliffe, and a D.Min. from the Church Divinity School of the Pacific. In 2019, now Bishop MacDonald was elevated to Archbishop.
