Enroll at one of the local colleges, universities, or one of many online options, and take early care and education or child development courses that lead to certificates and degrees in Early Care and Education or Child Development.

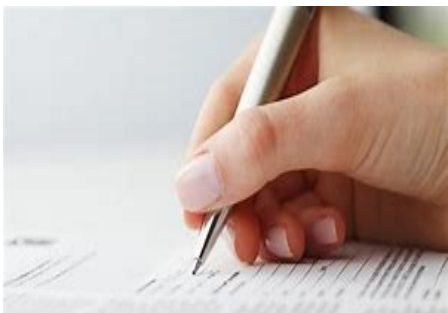


STEP 2

Complete coursework, earn a grade of “C” or better and submit a copy of your grade report to First 5 San Joaquin.
