ORDER REQUESTING
SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING

Before: GOULD and FRIEDLAND, Circuit Judges, and OTAKE,^{*} District Judge.

Assuming we were to hold that there is still a live controversy surrounding EPA's authority to regulate Plaintiffs' property, the parties are instructed to address the relevance, if any, of the Navigable Waters Protection Rule: Definition of "Waters of the United States," 85 Fed. Reg. 22,250 (April 21, 2020), to this appeal. The parties shall each file a supplemental brief not exceeding 10 pages in length. Plaintiffs shall submit their brief on or before March 26, 2021, and
