A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 to make the Reclamation Water Settlements Fund permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indian Water Rights
5 Settlement Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RECLAMATION WATER SETTLEMENTS FUND.**

7 Section 10501 of the Omnibus Public Land Manage-
8 ment Act of 2009 (43 U.S.C. 407) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “For each
2 of fiscal years 2020 through 2029” and inserting
3 “For fiscal year 2020 and each fiscal year there-
4 after”;

5 (2) in subsection (c)—

6 (A) in paragraph (1)(A), by striking “for
7 each of fiscal years 2020 through 2034” and
8 inserting “for fiscal year 2020 and each fiscal
9 year thereafter”; and

10 (B) in paragraph (3)(C), by striking “for
11 any authorized use” and all that follows
12 through the period at the end and inserting
13 “for any use authorized under paragraph (2).”;
14 and

15 (3) by striking subsection (f).

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
