

The Foundation of St. Andrew's School, Middletown, DE

St. Andrew's was founded in 1929 by [A. Felix du Pont](#) (1879–1948).

The headmasters who met in 1929 were taken to the former Comegys Farm to see the land that had been purchased for the school's location. They were invited to advise on the best way to proceed with the foundation of the school.

The school was founded to provide a top education for boys of all socio-economic backgrounds, regardless of their families' ability to pay.

St. Andrew's was originally a boys' school, but became coeducational in 1973.
