Pinecones

- 1. Cut a 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Sugar Cube cardstock; fold in half.
- 2. Cut 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" piece of Toffee cardstock and samp with the Woodgrain Background stamp using Sugar Cube ink.
- 3. Cut a piece of Sugar Cube cardstock to 7. 3" x 4 1/8". Lightly brush Salt Water Taffy 8. ink from one corner of the panel outward. Stamp various pine boughs with Sweet Basil and Dijon ink. Splatter the panel with gold ink.
- 4. Stamp the large pinecone and the small pinecone layers as follows, then die cut:
 - Base layer in Toffee
 - Second layer in Chocolate Truffle stamped off once on scrap paper.
 - Top layer in Chocolate Truffle
 - Tip: There is a fourth layer to the large that can be stamped in white or can be white embossed for "snow." It is not used in this sample.

- 5. Die cut the frame from Sugar Cube cardstock using the second Stitched Frame Stacklets die.
- 6. Die cut the Hello Script two times from Chocolate Truffle cardstock. Adhere to each other to add dimension.
- 7. Die cut the bow from Sweet Basil cardstock.
- 8. Assemble the layers all as shown, using foam adhesive for the frame. Attach the pinecones, bow, and hello. Embellish with gold sequins.
