

What to Read While Staying at Home from Mary Ellen Casey

These are some of my all-time favorite books. Hope you find something here of interest!

***Emma* by Jane Austen.** After *Pride and Prejudice*, my favorite Austen novel. A well-intentioned and supremely self-confident young woman sets about managing the lives of those around her. A bit frothy but with Austen's usual incisive social observations.

***All the Light We Cannot See* by Anthony Doer.** The lives of a young blind French girl and a German radio operator ultimately intersect in this masterful novel of German-occupied France during World War II.

***Into Thin Air* by Jon Krakauer.** The gripping story of one of the deadliest summit seasons on Mt. Everest, written by one of the climbers.

***Shadow Divers* by Robert Kurson.** Two scuba divers discover a sunken German U-boat, complete with crew, off the New Jersey coast and spend the next six years and numerous dives trying to solve the mystery of how it wound up there.

The Winds of War* and *War and Remembrance by Herman Wouk. A sweeping tale of World War II told through the experiences of one far-flung American naval family.
