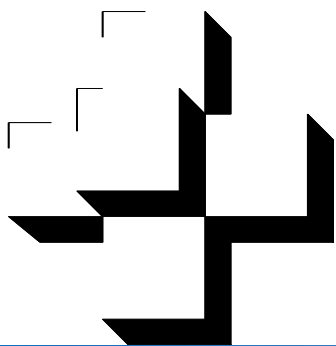

2025 Flower Calendar

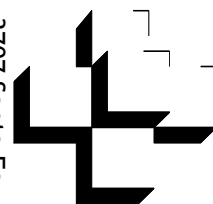
