Vital Congregations The Mark # 4: Empowering Servant Leadership

I attended seminary in the early 1980's when about a third of my classmates were women. Women had been ordained in the church for years but there was still a significant employment gap between the genders.

The seminary held a community forum on the topic of "Ordination," What does it mean? Do you have to be ordained to serve? Are there particular ministries for which ordination is a requirement?

Dr. John Burkhardt delved into the etymology and said, "'Ordo' means 'power.'" Ordination comes from the same root word as ordinance. Preachers and cannonballs! While he was right, I was offended. In my mind, I was entering into ordained ministry to serve. Years later, I recognize that both "power" and "service" are part of being ordained.

Empowering Servant Leadership is brain twister. Empowering is what you do to encourage someone who is sitting meekly on the sidelines to get into the game and be a star. Servant is someone who either lacks power or voluntarily sets aside power in order to provide for the needs of someone else. Leadership is that quality of being able to rally other people for a particular task or assignment.

As a mark of a Vital Congregation, empowering servant leadership is modeling ourselves after Jesus. Jesus was empowered by God to make a difference. Jesus made a difference by his acts of servanthood. Jesus' servanthood was a form of leadership as others adopted a similar lifestyle, helping the least, the last, and the lost.

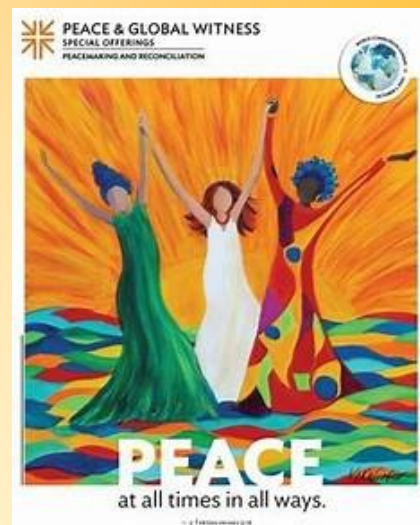

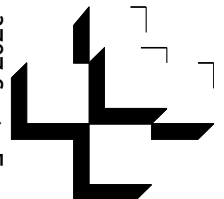
