## ACTIVITY: FROG CRAFT

## SUPPLIES:

- 1 empty toilet paper roll
- Paint and paint brush

- String or twine
- Small pom-poms
- 2 small googly eyes
- Paper to make insect wings, frog arms, legs and polka dots
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape



## DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut an empty toilet paper roll in half.
2. Tape one end shut.
3. Paint the inside of the roll red. This is the frog's mouth.
4. Paint the outside any color you would like so that your frog can blend with its environment.
5. Let the paint dry.
6. Cut paper to make 2 frog legs and 2 frog arms.
7. Glue the arms and legs onto the toilet paper roll.
8. Glue polka dots onto the frog's back.
9. Make the frog's eyes out of red paper.
10. Create an insect by gluing small googly eyes and wings onto a small pom- pom.
11. Attach the pom-pom to your string or twine with glue and glue the other end of the string into the frog's mouth.
