### JOIN US IN HONORING OUR VETERAN OF THE MONTH

We are recognizing Roy Hughes, Sergeant, U.S. Army, India, Burma, & China

Roy B. Hughes was born January 25, 1925, in the Village of Shelby, Michigan. His mother died when he was just seven years old, but she made him promise that he would graduate from high school - a promise that he kept. On June 18, 1943, 22 days after graduating from Pentwater High School, he entered the United States Army in Detroit, Michigan. He was trained as a military policeman and medical aid. His first assignment took him to Fort Sill, Oklahoma, where he guarded and escorted German prisoners of war to various camps throughout Oklahoma.


In spring of 1944, he was sent overseas to the Indo-China Theatre. He landed in India and made his way through Burma and eventually into China. The last assignment was in Shanghai, China, where he was assigned as a Military Policeman conducting roving city patrols, checking passes and credentials, assisting civilian police and quelling uprisings. In total, Sgt. Hughes served 15 months in India and China. He was awarded two battle stars for his service in Central Burma and the China Offensive. He was awarded the American Theatre Service Medal, the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Service Medal and Good Conduct Medal.

On July 14, 1946, he was separated from the Army at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin. He returned to Pentwater and an old friend and fellow veteran who was in the Navy talked him into working on the car ferries on Lake Michigan. He started his career on August 29, 1946 and ended his career on December 11, 1946. As he would say, "I survived Burma and China, not to die during a winter storm on Lake Michigan."

Roy met Maxine Tyler through his old Navy buddy (yes, the same one) and they married on November 7, 1947. Roy bounced around Muskegon working at various places until he got into the management program with F. W. Woolworth Company in late fall, 1949. For the next 39 years, he managed a number of stores throughout Indiana and Illinois with his last store being located in Decatur, Illinois. He retired in 1988.

During their marriage of almost 46 years, Roy and Maxine had three boys. Roy passed away on August 29, 1993. But Roy's legacy of public service continued through his sons. Ron went into education, Wayne served in the Air Force with a tour in Vietnam, and he and Ric, the youngest brother, ended up retiring from the Decatur Police Department. But, the legacy does not end there. Of the six grandchildren that Roy and Maxine had - Adam retired from Oak Park Public Safety; Don is a U. S. Deputy Marshal as well as a retired SFC, U.S. Army; and Sarah works as the Associate Director of Veteran Services at Kent State University. Rachel served in the United States Marine Corp and is a former Macon County, Illinois, Corrections Officer. She currently works for Macon County Veterans Service Center. Jessica and Laura work in health careers.

We at Rosedale Gardens would like to recognize and honor Roy Hughes' contribution to the safety and security of this great nation. We thank him for his dedicated and honorable service. Well done, good and faithful servant.
