




JOIN US IN HONORING OUR VETERAN OF THE MONTH

We are recognizing Merrill “Mert” Thomas Sergeant, U.S. Army

Mert’s draft number came up during the fall of 1951. He was in college and set to graduate in the spring of 1952. Thankfully, he was able to get a deferment so that he could finish his Bachelor’s Degree in Music Education before he had to leave for the service.

He began his service in Fort Meade, MD in October of 1952 while the Korean War was raging in the far east. From there, Mert was sent to Fort Leonard Wood in Rolla, MO. His talents as an excellent musician earned him a spot playing trumpet in the 6th Armored Division Band. Being part of this group meant that Mert played at many parades and concerts. Another one of his duties while in the Army was playing “Taps” at funerals, which he always considered a humble privilege.

In December of 1952, Mert married his college sweetheart, Helen, and brought her to Missouri with him. She turned out to be even more of an asset than he had first imagined. On weekends, Mert played in a dance band. When Helen came along, the guys decided that the band could use her as a singer.

Mert did not only play in the band when he was in Rolla. He also showed that he had great organizational and clerical skills. He was so valuable to his commanding officer that when he was twice called up to go to Germany, and once to Korea, his CO refused to let him go. Of course the missed trips to Germany were very disappointing to Mert and Helen. However, they were very grateful that his CO would not let him go to Korea.

During his time in the army, Mert managed to advance from Private up to the rank of Sergeant. When he was discharged in the summer of 1954, he and Helen moved back to Mert’s hometown of Athens, OH. He returned to his alma mater of Ohio University and earned his Master’s Degree in Music. Both he and Helen found jobs as Instrumental and Vocal Music Teachers in Dearborn, as well as Choir Directors at Garden City Presbyterian Church. They moved to Livonia in 1962, and in 1969 left their jobs at Garden City Presbyterian Church to start attending Rosedale Gardens Presbyterian Church with their two children. They loved finding their new church family and being longtime members of the Chancel Choir. Mert spent his entire educational career with Dearborn Public Schools.
