Captain, Livonia Police Department



Captain Jessica Sabbadin was born and raised in Livonia where she attended Franklin High School. Jessica began her career with the Livonia Police Department in June 2000. Over the years, she has served in a variety of roles, including assignments in both the Patrol Bureau and the Detective Bureau. In 2016, she was promoted to Sergeant and shortly thereafter she was selected as the Officer in Charge of the Special Victims Unit, where she demonstrated a strong commitment to supporting and advocating for the vulnerable populations.

In 2023, she was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant and assigned to the Uniform Division before quickly transitioning over to be the Commanding Officer of the Investigative Division. In 2025, she was promoted to the rank of Captain and currently directs operations as the Commander of the Uniform Division.

Captain Sabbadin has been a dedicated member of the Western Wayne County Crisis Negotiation Team since 2009 and currently serves as the team's Commanding Officer. She is a graduate of the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command and has attended the FBI-LEEDA Command Leadership Institute.

Jessica is married and continues to enjoy family life in the Livonia community with their three young children, Charlie (7), Easton (4), and Leah (2), as well as their dog, Cheeto, and bunny, Benny.
