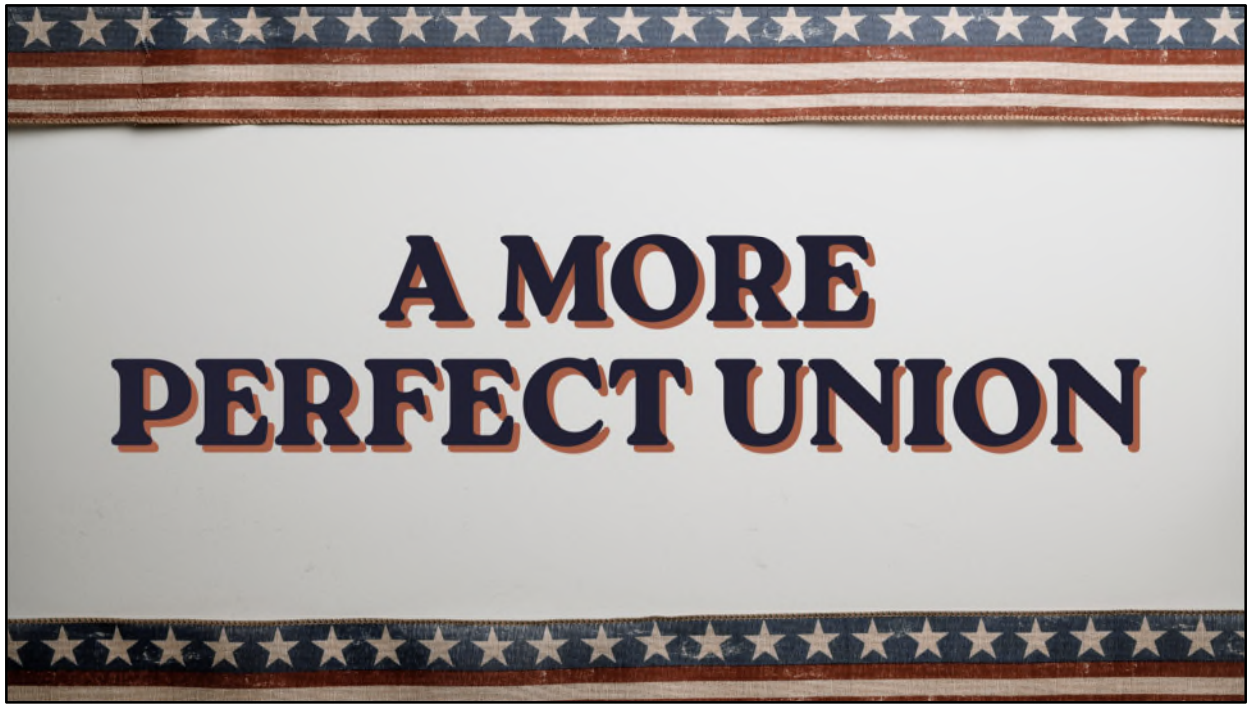

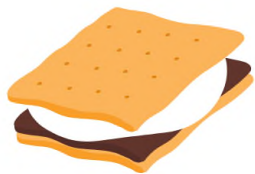

JULY MENTAL HEALTH FOCUS: BE A KID AGAIN!



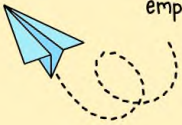
National Be a Kid Again Day is celebrated annually on July 8th, but here at RGPC we are going to celebrate it all month long!

This is an informal observance that encourages adults to take a break from responsibility and embrace playfulness, creativity, curiosity, and joy. This promotes a youthful mindset, which research shows can improve overall well-being. Studies have found that maintaining a positive, childlike attitude can reduce stress, anxiety, and depression, and even contribute to better heart health and longevity. It is widely credited to Nolan Bushnell, founder of Atari and Chuck E. Cheese, who emphasized the importance of play for all ages.



To celebrate, do something from this list:

- Play outdoor games: Swing, slide, hopscotch, tag, water balloon fights, or fly a kite.
- Enjoy childhood treats: Eat favorite cereals, ice cream sundaes, or popsicles.
- Get creative: Draw with sidewalk chalk, finger paint, build forts (indoors or out), or make paper airplanes.
- Watch cartoons or movies: Spend time enjoying animated shows from your childhood including TV cartoons and Disney-style movies.
- STEM-inspired fun: Explore science through hands-on activities like baking experiments, building projects, or visiting a zoo or park to learn about nature.
- Social activities: Host a sleepover, play board games, or gather friends and family for playful competitions.



STEPHEN MINISTER TRAINING BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER

What Am I Celebrating?

I've been on a mission to purge my closet, nightstand and dresser drawers. So far I have taken 2 large black bags and 2 tall kitchen bags to a collection box and 1 tall kitchen bag to the trash. Yea, me.

While sorting I found a t-shirt I bought in Washington D.C. 2 years ago while attending the national convention of the League of Women Voters. "The United States of America" is beautifully embroidered above an eagle emblem. "United." Easy word to say. Difficult to live. In fact, there's never been a time in our 250-year existence when that has 100% accurately described our nation. Our Republic was founded on a set of beliefs, among them the idea that all people are created equal. All people. And that all the people have the fundamental right to live their life freely, without fear, and pursue their potential. Given current divisions in culture and politics, choosing "honest" music for this weekend was challenging. Storybook "hooray-for-us" music felt disingenuous and naïve on my part. Discordant arrangements conveying doom and hopelessness also felt unsatisfactory. So I settled on three renditions of *The Star Spangled Banner*.

Prelude - ***Toccata on the National Anthem*** by Lothar Beadermann, a German composer. The melody is in the footwork while ordered chaos erupts on the manuals (the keyboards). There's a short reprieve during "the rockets red glare" section, after which strength and frenzy resume.

Offertory - ***The Star Spangled Banner*** from *'Finding Peace in the Land That We Love'*, arranged by K. L. Phillips, is deeply reflective. Written in 2021, after the confusion, fear and isolation of Covid, Phillips offers respite. Join me in a lovely moment to let fear, division and chaos subside. Just breathe.

Postlude - ***Fugue on the National Anthem***. A simple round such as "Row, Row, Row Your Boat" could be called a fugue for children. In this fugue, also by Beadermann, various parts seem to flee from and chase each other in an intricate dance. In this organ piece, that means the melody is introduced by my right hand, followed by my left hand, followed by my feet. After the melody has been heard, it runs away from the next part, which takes up the same theme and sets off in pursuit. While this organ fugue is relatively brief, a true fugue can be long and extremely complex, kind of how I feel this July 4th week.

So I return to where I began, to "united". Let us, Jesus's church, be united in word and deed around who he taught us is our neighbor. If life is not lived freely, without fear, by our "neighbor", then a "more perfect union" eludes us still.

I would like to thank all of my wonderful friends at RGPC for the healing prayers that were sent to our loving God on my behalf during the last three challenging months.

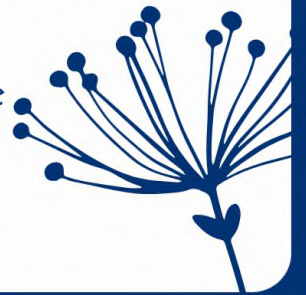

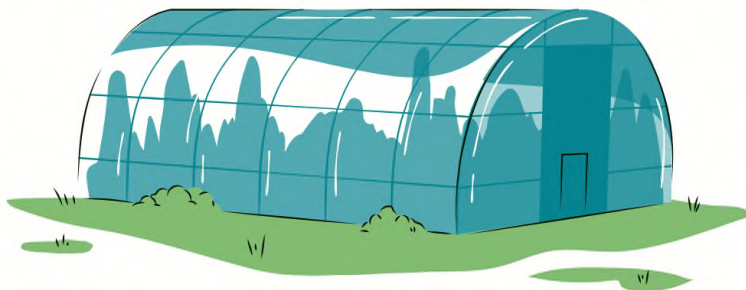
Pastor Kellie's SABBATICAL

In January of 2000, Wail Bamieh, Jim Morisi, and Milton Zussman purchased the Big Boy Restaurant located at 33427 Plymouth Road in Livonia. In March of 2014, Jim and Wail decided to part with the Big Boy Restaurant Group and start their own concept. Annie's Family Restaurant and Bake Shoppe officially opened its doors on March 8, 2014.

The name "Annie's" was chosen to honor the legacy of Jim's lovely wife Annie, who passed away in 2000. Her famous recipes are still being used at the restaurant today in most of their soups and home cooking.

Their presence is felt by all those at Annie's through the love, warmth, and exemplary service that is provided to all of their customers, which Annie's calls "The 3 Q's" – quality cleanliness, food, and service.
