## These suggested activities are entirely optional.

**Draw** (K -2nd grade) a picture or cut out and mount, on unlined paper, a picture from a magazine or newspaper of a delicious looking Thanksgiving meal.

(3<sup>rd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>)Then, for EACH item, use 3 adjectives in <u>a</u> complete sentence to describe EACH of your selected items. Your six complete sentences will be written on lined paper. Use the complete heading format.

**Cut** from a newspaper or grocery store sale ad that includes prices for six (6) Thanksgiving food items.

Compose word problems to go along with each sale ad.

For example:

<u>Grades K- 2nd:</u> How much does a can of cranberry cost? <u>Grades  $3^{rd}$  - 5th</u>: How much would it cost to buy a can of peas and a can of corn? How much change would you get if you paid for those two things with a \$5 bill? How much would a 20-pound turkey cost? <u>Grades  $6^{th}$  - 8th</u>: Use the store ads to plan a complete Thanksgiving dinner for you and your family. (Your budget is \$40. Show pictures of your selected items that will total \$40. Tell how much your feast cost per person. (Use unlined paper)


