JANUARY 2025

CELEBRATING OUR 20TH ANNIVERSARY

MMF began the year continuing critical family support, providing financial assistance, comfort items, and encouragement to families with children actively in cancer treatment.

Planning and outreach efforts laid the groundwork for another year of meaningful impact.

MARCH 2025

3-ON-3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

The MMF 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament brought the community together through friendly competition, raising both funds and awareness for families facing pediatric cancer.

Hosted at LuHi in Brookville, the event raised proceeds that directly supported children in treatment and the Foundation's year-round family assistance programs.



APRIL 2025

EXPANDING OUR DISTRACTION BAG PROGRAM

MMF continued delivering Distraction Bags to help children cope with procedures, treatments, and extended hospital visits.

Items are collected year-round through social media, board members, and volunteers.

In 2025, the program expanded to the Pediatric Emergency Room, Endoscopy Suite, and all outpatient pediatric facilities at NYU Langone Long Island, with volunteer groups and schools supporting hands-on service projects for pediatric oncology patients.





MAY 2025

Spring outreach strengthened MMF's mission through family support initiatives and community-based fundraising efforts.

The Melville Chamber of Commerce hosted a BINGO Night, expanding awareness and introducing MMF to new supporters. Families also received assistance that helped ease emotional and financial stress during treatment.

This month included an event hosted by NGIL (Next Generation Industry Leaders) at The Union League Club in NYC, where young professionals gathered to learn more about MMF's mission and vision.





JUNE 2025

The annual MMF Golf Outing brought together golfers, sponsors, and supporters for a meaningful day of generosity and community.

Hosted at Cold Spring Country Club, the outing raised \$232,750, playing a significant role in sustaining MMF's programs throughout the summer months.

June was an especially busy month and also included Dine for a Difference, hosted at Appliance World. The event welcomed a crowd of more than 150 guests and featured participation from many Long Island restaurants, bakeries, and wine establishments.





JULY 2025

Summer events and generous donor support allowed MMF to continue bringing joy to children through special gifts, meaningful experiences, and family-centered surprises.

During this time, the Foundation launched its annual Backpack Program, delivering more than 150 fully stocked backpacks to local pediatric oncology hospitals, the SIBS Center, and NYU Pediatrics.

In addition, South Woods Middle School proudly adopted MMF for 2025 and presented the Foundation with a donation of more than \$3,000, further supporting families in need.

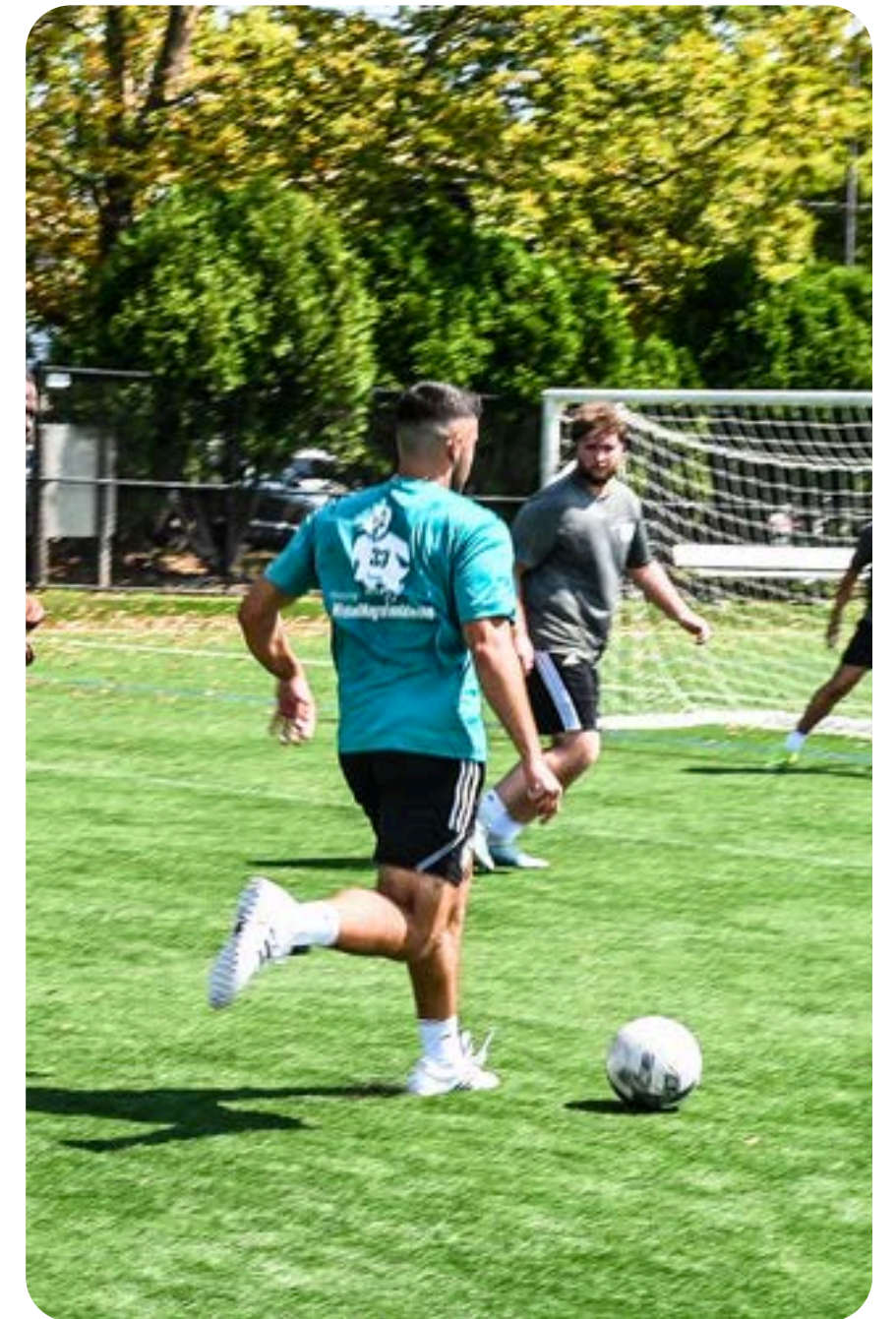


AUGUST 2025

That same day, Saturday, August 2nd, The Mastermind Unit hosted the 18th Annual Soccer for a Cause at Kevin Kolm Park. The event raised more than \$20,000 in support of MMF's mission.





SEPTEMBER 2025

CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

As children returned to school, MMF continued providing comfort and encouragement to families balancing education and ongoing treatment.

In recognition of Childhood Cancer Awareness Month in September, the Small Wishes, Big Smiles program created a memorable experience by sending a family to enjoy a New York Mets game at Citi Field.

The month also marked an exciting milestone with MMF's first Sporting Clays event, A Day of Breaking Clays and Building Hope, made possible through strong community partnerships.





OCTOBER 2025

Awareness efforts throughout the month highlighted the resilience of children battling cancer and the vital role that community support plays.

Through the Small Wishes, Big Smiles program, two families were treated to a memorable New York Islanders game, sharing a joyful evening together and creating lasting memories.

That same night, MMF was honored to participate as one of the community charities at the home game. More than \$21,000 was raised through the 50/50 raffle, with 25% of the proceeds donated directly to MMF in support of families facing pediatric cancer.





NOVEMBER 2025

During Thanksgiving and pre-holiday outreach, MMF provided families with financial support and essential resources, helping ease the burden during a particularly sensitive time of year.

In response to reductions in food assistance benefits, MMF launched a targeted campaign to support affected families. The community came together to raise \$7,000, which was distributed as gift cards to help families meet everyday needs.

As the season continued, gratitude for MMF's donors and volunteers took center stage as preparations began for holiday giving and year-end support.





DECEMBER 2025

MMF's Holiday Adopt-A-Family Program provided \$1,000 checks, gift cards, toys, and winter essentials to families with children currently in treatment, helping ease financial and emotional stress during the holidays.

End-of-year events, hospital visits, and meaningful community partnerships ensured families felt remembered, supported, and surrounded by care.

The year concluded with the Mix & Mingle fundraising event on December 8, along with focused year-end donation outreach. MMF also proudly participated in Champions for Charity, extending our impact through community-driven giving.
