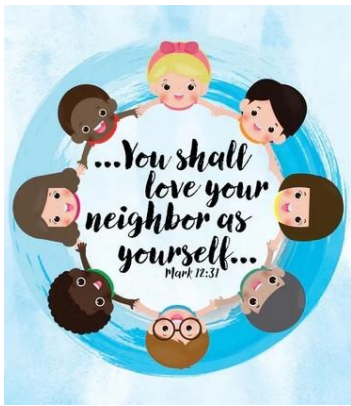




LOOKING FOR A WAY TO VOLUNTEER?

BOARD OF DIACONATE needs:

- **Ushers for Sunday worship** – you do not need to usher every Sunday. You do need to be here on your given day by 9:30 a.m. and then you are done after worship, which is around 11:00 a.m. You are asked to sit in a pew close to the door you are assigned during worship.
 - The door positions also help with the offertory.
- **Greeters** – Do you like saying hello? Would you like to welcome newcomers (and members) to our church? This position is located in the Narthex. The Greeter stays in the Narthex throughout the entire service and monitors the front door. (We have latecomers 😊) This position also takes the head count of the service. (No worries, we will help you and it sounds more overwhelming than it is!)
- **Flower Delivery** – Every Sunday the Diaconate is provided with a small bouquet of flowers and the name and address of someone in our congregation that needs a smile or a check-in. You can deliver any time after worship.
- **Acolyte Helper** – Help our coordinator, Lisa Rotenberger, guide our acolytes down the aisle at the beginning and the end of church. You would need to be in the Narthex at 9:50 a.m. and then again just before or during the offertory. You get to remain in worship the rest of the time. A background check will be required. (You would be working with children, and this is an absolute requirement.)

BOARD OF MEMBERSHIP needs:

- **Cookie pick-up** - Sunday morning cookies and deliver them to the church by 9:00 a.m. every Sunday. If you keep your receipt and turn it into the administrator, you are reimbursed for the expense. (Remember: the church cannot reimburse any taxes.)
- **Red Umbrella Welcome Table** – Be one of the first individuals someone meets when they come to worship! The Red Umbrella table is located on the front pavers of the main entrance to the church. Duties include setting the table up at 9:15 a.m., welcoming folks to worship and handing information materials out. Duties end at 9:55 a.m., at which time you would put away the table and supplies and head on into worship.
