What is this event?

The International dinner is a celebration of culture and diversity within the Magnet community, complete with entertainment from some of Magnet's talented musicians, thanks to Mr. Grimshaw!

Who can participate?

Made for all to attend as a community building event.

What does PIE provide?

PIE provides the tables, plateware, chafing dishes, serving pans, tablecloths, drinks and gloves. We also supply student volunteers to help you serve the evening of the event. PIE will offer a \$75.00 stipend per table to help offset food costs.



What do I (or my team) have to provide?

The table for each country (which can be one person or a few people working together) will have to pick a country and provide 2-4 dishes from that country. The dishes should each be made to serve 150 small sample size portions. The pans provided will fit neatly into chafing dishes. Please also bring your own serving utensils and any decorations that might enhance the table. Examples would be linens from the country or a small flag or figurines from the represented country.

When do I bring the food?

The food should be brought hot (if to be served hot) the night of between 4:45-5:00 pm.

Who can volunteer?

Anyone can volunteer - students, parents, supporters. Students can volunteer and will be used as servers and clean up the night of and for set up on Friday, October 20 (3:45-5:30 pm).
