ESSENTIAL NEEDS



Lead efforts to begin state investment in the statewide 211 coalition for resource referral and disaster recovery services provided to Iowans.



Support efforts to address affordable housing and reduce cost-burdens for families seeking homeownership.



Support a direct appropriation for the Double Up Food Bucks program allowing SNAP participants better access to healthy, nutritious fruits and vegetables.



Support efforts to increase SNAP access post-pandemic by bringing Iowa's income eligibility more in line with federal guidelines.

Support efforts to increase funding for the Statewide Voluntary Preschool Program to allow more families to access the program.



Continue to support English-language learners by increasing opportunities and funding for instruction and support.
