

GJPS: K-12 Online Learning Guide

2021-2022



General Information:

- The district will use the third party vendor, SchoolsPLP, to deliver the curriculum to students enrolled in the blended learning model.
- SchoolsPLP curriculum addresses Ohio standards, but does not match our GJPS curriculum.
- All GJPS course offerings are not available through SchoolsPLP.
- Families choosing to enroll in the online learning model will be making a yearlong commitment.
- Online learning includes some in-person requirements.
- Although the online learning model allows students some control on the timing and pace for learning, a daily Google Meet check-in is a requirement for the GJPS model.

Grading and Reporting:

- SchoolsPLP grades are based on mastery of content and completion of curriculum.
- Grade reports will be generated by SchoolsPLP and sent to families following the regular GJPS reporting schedule.
- At the completion of the year, SchoolsPLP grades will be transferred into Infinite Campus.
- Parents will have the ability to check student progress and mastery when desired throughout the school year.

In-Person Requirements:

- Orientation (student and parent/guardian) - Tuesday, August 10 (1:00-2:30)
- District Assessments
- Special programming services as appropriate
- Other opportunities as deemed appropriate for individual students

Attendance:

- Attendance for students in SchoolPLP must still be reported to the Ohio Department of Education
- Attendance will be tracked using:
 - Daily Google Meets with assigned GJPS staff
 - Completion of SchoolsPLP curriculum
 - Time logged using district online curricular tools and other supplemental learning activities as determined by SchoolsPLP or GJPS

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Special Programming:

- Special education services will be provided by a GJPS teacher.
- SchoolsPLP does not provide a modified curriculum for students with disabilities.

- Gifted services are not available for students opting into SchoolsPLP.
- EL services will be provided by a GJPS teacher.

Teacher Assignment:

- Students will be assigned a SchoolsPLP teacher and a SchoolsPLP mentor.
- Students will also be assigned a GJPS staff member for ongoing support and daily check-ins.
 - GJPS staff will host parent-teacher conferences twice throughout the year.

Device Access and Support:

- Students enrolled in the online learning model will be issued a district-provided Chromebook.
- Families in need of internet service can request a hotspot to support online learning.
- Technical support will be available through the GJPS tech department and support tickets can be submitted through <https://helpdesk.gjps.org> (using the student's username and password) or by emailing technology@gjps.org.
