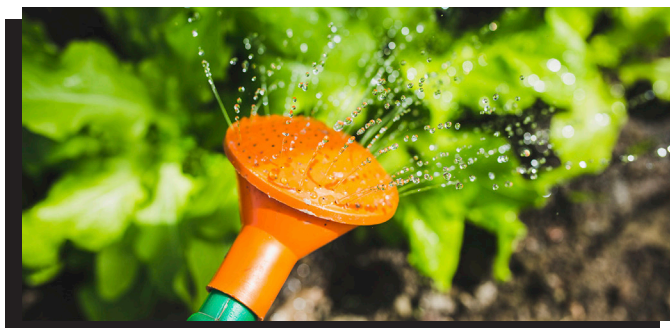
OPPORTUNITIES FOR RESIDENTS TO REDUCE WASTE
