

Access to the Infant Toddler, Preschool and Birth-5 ePyramid Model Module Packages is now available FREE to the NH early childhood community.

Thanks to a collaborative funding effort\* these three (3) online Pyramid Model module packages are now available at [ProSolutions](#), a learning management platform that is well known to NH child care teachers and administrators. Families and higher education students as well as those in the public school system, Head Start, home visiting and Early Supports and Services sectors are likely less familiar with this platform but be assured it is a very simple system to navigate.

Accessing the modules is easy. The first step is to go to the [ProSolutions](#) site and create an account.

Next, select “New Hampshire” and click ‘search’ which will bring you to the NH Course Catalog where you’ll find the 3 modules.

Each module contains 18 hours of content. These are self-paced modules available to learners 24/7. There will also be opportunities available for participation in facilitated professional learning communities (PLCs) to discuss the content and application with other participants. More information about these PLCs will be coming soon.

One last bit of information to share. [ProSolutions](#) and the [New Hampshire Professional Registry](#) are linked. The Registry is a data collection tool that allows you to track and share your professional development activities. While the Registry is now used primarily by child care teachers and administrators, anyone in the NH early childhood community can create an account. Once created, your completion of an eModule on ProSolutions will be documented in your Registry account. This is a convenient method for keeping track of your completed PD hours. You will also receive a certificate from ProSolutions at the completion of the modules.

Both ProSolutions and the Registry are intuitive systems that are easy to navigate. If you experience any glitches feel free to reach out and I will direct you to the appropriate resource.
