Training Description: Join us for this **two-day training on the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale (ECERS-3)**. If you work with Preschool, Pre-K or Kindergarten age group, this training is designed for you and will introduce you to the ECERS-3. You'll uncover where and when the scales are used and how they measure quality in your program. **Activities will be provided that will help you become more familiar with the format and content of the ECERS-3.** We will discuss how the scale requirements can be interpreted and scored and how procedures for completing observations can be conducted. Additionally, in-depth information will be shared about specific items of the scale, indicators and research findings.
