Early Childhood Tuition Assistance Grant

Apply to Receive Tuition Assistance

Funded by the NH Bureau of Child Development and Head Start Collaboration, the Early Childhood Tuition Assistance (ECTA) Grant at Granite State College is applicable to one course per term.

Do I Qualify?

This grant is available to teachers working a minimum of 20 hours per week in a NH licensed center, and directors working a minimum of 30 hours per week in a NH licensed center.

Important Information Regarding the ECTA Grant

Applications will be reviewed as received. Applications fill fast so apply early. Money is awarded at 100% tuition for your first Early Childhood Education course (PSY 508 Child Development), EDU 602, EDU 544, PSY 510 or 50% tuition for subsequent Early Childhood Education courses. Students are responsible for all materials needed for the course and the \$90 registration fee.

Awarded money will be removed from a student's account and they will be billed for the total cost of the course for the following reasons:

- Students withdraw from the course after the add/drop period
- Students do not participate in the course after registering
- Students stop participating in the course after registering
- Students do not receive a passing grade in the course

- When the grant opens, registration forms will be sent to all students that completed and submitted the inquiry form.
- After reviewing the application, students will receive a letter if they are awarded the grant.
- Applications fill fast so submit your inquiry form early.
